Dear Parents and Carers,

It is a priority for Kilmoreie to increase the diversity of representation in its current library books and in particular to increase the number of books written by, and representing people from black and other minority ethnic backgrounds.

Thanks to a generous donation from a parent that the Friends of Kilmoreie have matched using the £570 raised from autumn trail donations, the school is planning to buy books from [Moon Lane Ink](#), a fantastic local bookshop and community interest company which is dedicated to raising equality in children's books. Together, this money should enable the school to purchase around £50 worth of books for every class.

Moon Lane Ink have put together a carefully curated list of quality titles suitable for classes across the school to reflect London's diverse population and ensure that all students can see themselves and their families represented in the books at school.

We wanted to open up the opportunity to donate additional books to all parents at Kilmoreie. From 30<sup>th</sup> November until the end of December Moon Lane Ink will keep a copy of the list of books behind the till so parents can pop in (when they reopen) or call up on [0203 489 7030](tel:02034897030) and choose an additional book to buy for the school. All books purchased by Kilmoreie parents will then be stamped with a message from us all and given to the school in January.
