DONATIONS UPDATE

Early Years Outstanding Outdoor Spaces - FOK

is donating an additional £5,000 to this project, on top of £5,000 in sponsorship money raised by our 2020/21 Vitality Big Half team. The £10,000 from FOK will be added to £23,981 in Perry Vale Ward NCIL funding if Kilmore's application is successful!

Class Resource Allowance - New for 2021/22,

FOK is donating £100 to every class teacher to spend on resources for their classrooms.

School Trip Allowance - FOK is donating £3450

to go towards the cost of coach travel for school trips etc. This money will enable the kids to go on trips that can't practically be done on public transport, such as the Year 1 trip to Leeds Castle.

Outdoor Quiet Room - The new garden building

funded by FOK in 2018/19 has been taking shape with the help of a great team of parent volunteers. The plan is for it to be used as a quiet space for children during play times and we're hoping that it will be ready for the children this side of half term.
